The treatments for PCCP shall be minor treatments, and shall not include any overlays, regardless of overlay pavement type. Base and subbase treatments that are used to repair surface defects (i.e. faulting, ride) caused by subgrade failure (i.e. subsidence), shall be included as minor treatments
