### 8) Chip Seal specification

John Cheever brought copies of the chip seal specifications. He has cleaned it up and made the changes that the task force discussed previously. This specification was still in word perfect so much of it had to be completely recreated. He noted that this spec refers to AASHTO test numbers while most of the MGPEC specifications use ASTM or have a reference to both tests. John said that in most cases there is a difference between the AASHTO test procedures and the ASTM tests. The task force decided to do some research and request comments from people that are more familiar with chip seal before taking action. A copy of the specification is attached. Comments from interested parties are requested.

The revisions this task force is making to the chip seal and slurry seal specification are intended to increase competition in the supply of aggregates. John provided laboratory test results for the aggregates that were recently used for chip seal and slurry seal that were placed recently on the Pikes Peak parking lot at DIA.
