February meeting minutes were approved.

4) Asphalt Crack Seal/Fill specifications.

Specification received final approval and will be sent to the Steering Committee for approval and adoption. The next steering committee meeting is April 21, 2011.

5) Concrete Crack Seal / Reseal specification.

Jamie distributed the Mn/DOT spec which he plans to use as a base for the MGPEC concrete repair specifications.
Based on this specification Jamie will develop a wide range of specifications for concrete repairs. A partial list is sealing and resealing of joints, partial depth repairs, full depth repairs including tie bar placement.
After the new specifications have been developed the task force will recommend where they fit best into the MGPEC specification manual.

6) Pavement Stabilization/Jacking specification

Richard has contacted Tom Peters about his experience with stabilization with grout but Tom didn't have the information readily available so follow up will be necessary. Dave Potter said that Pat Kennedy may be able to provide some information.

7) Slurry Seal specification

Scott will supply another electronic copy of his slurry seal specification to the task force members. Most task force members seem to have misplaced the one he sent previously.

8) Chip Seal specification

John Cheever suggests changing the LA Abrasion requirement from 20 to 25 in the new spec. There was general agreement that breakdown of the aggregate is not the failure mechanism associated with the life of seal coats. So this appears to be a logical change to increase competition in the marketplace without sacrificing quality.

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Jon also showed the task force a sample of 3/8 minus aggregate that they could supply for color comparison. The sample color was generally grey with light pink tones. In residential areas surface color can be an important factor in customer satisfaction.
